In case of injury due to work accident, the seatarer is entitled to sickness provisions (medical treatment/medical wages) for a period of ca. 26 weeks from the company, and thereafter to medical treatment and medical wages for further 52 weeks from the insurance company (BG - Verkehr), provided he supplies the necessary sick-note continiously to the BG - Verkehr. In case of assessed disability of more than 20 %, the seafarer is entitled to an accident pension from the BG - Verkehr.

8. SF: Seafarers Fees in accordance to §31.2 of the CBA. Seafarers Fees have to be paid anually as specified in the special agreement.

<sup>1.</sup> Any general purpose rating shall receive 10% higher basic wages and allowances compared to the highest rank of the positions hers/his job designation is supposed to cover.

<sup>2.</sup> A Seafarer who is over the age of 18 and who is not listed among the categories of ratings shall be paid at least the equivalent rate of an Ordinary Seaman.

<sup>3.</sup> In case no proper overtime records are kept, as required in the current Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA), the Seafarer shall be paid a lump sum for overtime worked calculated at 140 hours at the hourly overtime rate.

<sup>4.</sup> Chief Eng. Officer below 3.000 kW: 1st Eng. Officer wages apply and Chief Eng. Officer below 750kW: 2 nd Eng. Officer wages apply. In case the Chief Eng. is engaged in opening/closing the hatches or mooring/unmooring the vessel he is entitled to a bonus of US\$ 193,- per month.
